

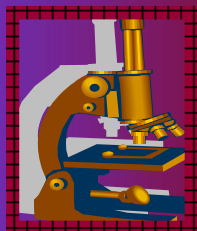

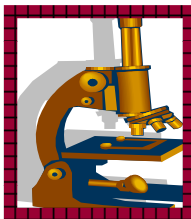

- Documentation of proficiency in oral (speech) & written communication (English) skills, as well as math and computer science

- Approved Portfolio (including all required artifacts), and Disposition Survey
