



## Enrollment Validation (Mandatory)

Validation is the last and final step in the registration process. Validation is a term used to verify that a student will be attending classes for which he/she has registered in a given semester and that all financial obligations associated with the registration have been settled. An indicator is placed in a data field of the student's record that prevents the cancellation of the class schedule when all conditions of validation have been met, i.e. **the student has indicated that he/she is returning for the semester or summer school, wishes to keep his/her current schedule and all financial obligations have been met.** *Payment arrangement is not available for summer school.*

When the indicator is not in the data field, it must be assumed that the student is not returning to SC State or does not want this same schedule. Therefore, absence of the indicator causes the schedule to be dropped at the stated deadline [Academic Calendar](#). If the student is returning to SC State after the schedule has been dropped, he/she must re-register for classes via [Bulldog Connection](#). **Classes the student originally wanted may not be available.**

If your balance is \$0 (**full financial aid or scholarship, cash, check, etc., and/or made payment arrangements**) and before the fee payment deadline, you **must** complete the Validation request as indicated below:
