The Nutrition and Food Management (NFM) program is an integral part of the Department of Family and Consumer Sciences at South Carolina State University. It is approved by the Commission on Accreditation/Approval for Dietetics Education of the American Dietetic Association. Students may choose the Nutrition or the Food Management option. Students who complete the Nutrition option and have met the University's minimum GPA requirement (2.00) will be issued five copies of a verification statement, which will enable them to apply for an American Dietetic Association (ADA) approved dietetic internship. Upon successfully completing the dietetic internship, students are eligible to take the registration examination for Registered Dietitians.

The Food Management option emphasizes areas of management and business and is designed for career opportunities in the hospitality industry and other food service areas. Students who choose the Food Management option however, are not eligible for a dietetic internship.
