Incident Summary:

Allegations were reported involving inter-organizational conduct between Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity and Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, including alleged theft and damage to property, and alleged verbal harassment during campus events. A separate physical altercation between members of the organizations occurred at an off-campus football game.

The Office of Equal Opportunity and the Office of Judicial Affairs conducted reviews in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct and university procedures. Evaluations were performed using a clear and convincing evidence standard.

Finding:

Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. – Beta Delta Chapter was **not found responsible** for larceny or malicious injury to property. Evidence did not meet the standard required to substantiate violations under the Student Code of Conduct. No hazing was identified or substantiated in this matter.

Sanctions / Disciplinary Actions:

None for hazing, larceny, or property damage findings.

Any conduct actions related to the off-campus physical altercation were addressed separately under the student conduct process.
