

# FINANCIAL AID FOR SUMMER SCHOOL

Eligible students will receive an award beginning in May indicating their Summer School financial aid based on the number of hours they are registered for during the Summer Sessions. Ineligible students will receive an email providing available options for summer aid.

- The Pell Grant program is now available for additional awards over the summer. Students can receive additional Pell Grant awards for the summer term(s) if they are in a minimum of six (6) hours and have not exhausted their Pell Lifetime eligibility. Enrollment is based on the total hours of all summer sessions.
- Students must enroll at least half time to borrow from the Federal Direct Loan Program. Students are encouraged to enroll at least half-time (6 hours for Undergraduate and 6 hours for Graduate) in the first Summer Session. Graduate students must be enrolled in six (6) hours of Graduate level courses in order to receive a Federal Direct Student or Graduate PLUS Loan.
- Financial Aid award will be based on the number of hours enrolled, residency and living status. Financial aid may be adjusted if your status changes.
- Summer School is an extension of the academic year including Fall and Spring semesters. Therefore, you must have a processed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file and have completed the verification process to be considered for summer financial aid. The FAFSA website is [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov).
- Students must be admitted into a degree seeking program to be eligible for aid.
- Financial Aid may be reduced or canceled for the Summer Session if you drop a course, the course is canceled by the University, you never attend or withdraw from courses. You may also be required to repay funds disbursed during the Summer Session.
- Students must attend Summer Session I and/or Summer Session II to be eligible for summer financial aid and enroll in the appropriate number of hours.

**Note: Students (New, Readmitted, & Transfer) enrolling for first or second Summer Session must have a required FAFSA on file by May.**

## Students who are not eligible for Summer Financial Aid:

- Students not in a degree program;
- Transition (Visiting) students from another college or university;
- Students not maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).

- ❖ You must have completed your **2019-2020** and **2020-2021 FAFSA Application** and *all required documents must be received in the Office of Financial Aid before an award is given.*
- ❖ You must be enrolled in at least six (6) hours to receive financial aid. If you are a new student, you must be fully accepted by the Admissions Office. **\*\*Note: Aid will not be awarded until enrolled.**
- ❖ If you are a transfer student, you must request a copy of your official transcript from the school(s) previously attended and submit to South Carolina State University Admissions Office or Graduate Studies.
- ❖ Complete the Financial Aid Summer School Application by **May 1<sup>st</sup>** and return it to the Office of Financial Aid.
